Class 1: Tips & Tricks for Analyzing & Knitting a Lace Pattern;
Gauge for Lace; Correcting mistakes;
Common lace cast-on; Reading charts

Class 2: Review work in progress & answer questions;
Attach beads if desired; Learn how to block lace

Requirements: Intermediate knitting skills

Supplies:

1. 1 skein sock yarn (approx 400-450 yds)
2. needles - size 5 or 6 (circular, approx 32 – 40 inches)
3. color pencils – Alco sells a box of 12 very inexpensively

Optional Supplies:

You may also wish to have:

1. Stitch markers to mark pattern repeats
2. A plastic knitting “safety” pin to mark the front of your work
3. “Tape” to mark your place in the lace pattern
